⁵ who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

- ⁸ The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.
- ⁹ He will not always accuse, nor will He harbor His anger forever;
- ¹⁰ He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.
- ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him;
- ¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.
